Selected Passages

Acts 18:9-10 (NIV)

One night the Lord spoke to Paul in a vision: "Do not be afraid; keep on speaking, do not be silent. ¹⁰For I am with you, and no one is going to attack and harm you, because I have many people in this city."

Philippians 1:14 (NKJV)

. . . and most of the brethren in the Lord, having become confident by my chains, are much more bold to speak the word without fear.

Job 11:15 (NIV)

. . . then you will lift up your face without shame; you will stand firm and without fear.

How to Share Jesus Without Fear

1. ALL OF US ARE SINNERS.

Romans 3:23 (NIV)

*. . . for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God
. . .*

2. SIN HAS SEVERE CONSEQUENCES.

Romans 6:23 (NIV)

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

3. WE MUST DO SOMETHING ABOUT OUR SITUATION.

John 3:3 (NIV)

In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."

4. GOD MADE A PROVISION FOR US.

John 14:6 (NIV)

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

5. WE RESPOND BY ADMITTING OUR SITUATION TO GOD.

Romans 10:9-10;13 (NIV)

That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. ¹³for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

6. WE CAN HAVE A TOTALLY DIFFERENT OUTLOOK ON LIFE.

2 Corinthian 5:15 (NIV)

And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.

7. WE RECEIVE GOD'S GIFT BY OPENING THE DOOR.

Revelation 3:20 (NIV)

"Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me."
